***Minutes of of LDMs and Department of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi Opening of Bank accounts of the students held on 14.07.2016 at 10.30 AM at Conference Hall of Oriental Bank of Commerce, Harsha Bhawan, E Block, Connaught Place, New Delhi.***

A meeting of LDMs and Department of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi was organized on 14.07.2016 at 10.30 AM to review the bank wise and district wise progress of Opening of pending accounts of the students of school of Govt. of NCT of Delhi at Conference Hall of Oriental Bank of Commerce, Harsha Bhawan, New Delhi.

At the outset GM & SLBC Convener, Sh. K.K. Acharya, SLBC-Delhi welcomed Sh. Ram Bilas Gupta SO from Department of Education of Govt. of NCT of Delhi LDMs, FLCs and all other participants.

Sh. K.K. Acharya stated that two special SLBC Meetings were held on 21.04.2016 and 09.05.2016 and 83<sup>rd</sup> Qtrly SLBC Meeting dated 20.05.2016 wherein detailed discussion was held on the subject and it was decided to open the accounts of all school children upto 10.07.2016 by organizing special camps in each school by the concerned mapped bank's branch between 01.07.2016 to 10.07.2016.

He further informed with concern that on the basis of data received from Banks and LDMs shows that progress of opening of accounts is very slow. He sought the reasons from LDMs for the slow progress.

As per feed back from LDMs/FLCs due to following main reason the progress has been slow:

1. Due to Eid festival many of students were not coming to schools;
2. The Accounts opening forms handed over to schools are either not filled up or not properly filled up;
3. Exact number of accounts to be opened in not clear as per feed back received from the schools;
4. Some of the students are absent for a long time;
5. Fresh admissions.

After that Sh. Ram Bilas Gupta from Education Department of Govt. of NCT of Delhi informed that as on date there are 14.77 lacs students out of which accounts of 3.17 lacs

students are pending for opening by the banks. Sh. Ram Bilas Gupta assured to make available the school wise/ bank branch wise details of all these 3.17 lacs pending accounts to SLBC today itself so that SLBC can further convey the same to the controlling heads and LDMs for taking further action by them for opening of these pending accounts.

On strategy for opening of pending accounts, it was decided that:

- Camps between 15.07.2016 to 22.07.2016 should be organized on daily basis till the opening of all pending accounts;
- The accounts opening forms as per number of pending accounts of the school will be made available to the school authority by the mapped bank branches. These forms will be get filled up/ completed by the students with assistance from the schools staff and will get deposited with the concerned bank branch so that these accounts may get opened.
- In case any school face any problem for getting accounts opening forms or opening of accounts, they may take up the matter with concerned LDM/SLBC and in case any bank branch face any problem in this matter from any school they may take up the issue with department of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi under intimation of concerned LDM/ SLBC so that the same may be sort out and pending accounts can be opened as per schedule.

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks.
