

Minutes of Meeting of Sub Committee to discuss/ review the achievements for the year 2015-16 and preparation of Annual Credit Plan 2016-17 on 28.01.2016 at 1.30 PM at Conference Hall of Oriental Bank of Commerce, Harsha Bhawan, New Delhi.

At the outset, Shri Navleen Kundra, GM & Convenor, SLBC, NCT of Delhi welcomed Ms. Juhi Mukherjee, IAS, DC(HQ), Controlling heads/ senior officials from the member banks, LDMs and all other participants.

On Targets & Achievements under Annual Credit Plan (ACP) 2015-16, Sh. Kundra showed his satisfaction on achievement under ACP 2015-16 upto the half year ended as on September 2015 and stated that the achievement under Priority Sector had been 54.88% and 76.67% under Non Priority Sector of the Annual Targets. Total Achievement had been 71.58% of the Annual Target for 2015-16 against the 50% of Annual Targets.

He also stated with concern that till date the progress under ACP 2015-16 upto December 2015 is received only from three districts i.e. 1. North 2. South 3. South East. He requested the LDMs of remaining districts to submit the same latest by 31.01.2016, positively so that Agenda Book for coming 82nd SLBC may be prepared in time.

On it all the concerned LDMs assured to submit the same latest by 31.01.2016

On preparation of Annual Credit Plan for 2016-17, Sh. Kundra stated that NABARD has prepared Potential Link Credit Plan for 2016-17 and Annual Credit Plan for 2016-17 is to be implemented from 01.04.2016.


All the LDMs/ Member Banks were requested to prepare the next year Annual Credit Plan 2016-17, with in time schedule, keeping in view the targets and achievements under ACP 2015-16 and the Potential Link Credit Plan (PLP) submitted by NABARD. LDMs were also requested to submit the District Credit Plan for 2016-17 of their districts well in time so that the ACP 2016-17 for the NCT-Delhi as a whole may be prepared and the same may be implemented w.e.f. 01.04.2016.

Mr. Kundra further asked the LDMs to invite MPs and MLAs in the DCC/DLRC meetings as per guidelines.

One LDM from Canara Bank informed that meetings are being organized and the DCs are attending these meetings but space is main issue while conducting these meetings.

Mr. Kundra asked all LDMs to address their grievances or performance related matters to their Controllers of the concerned banks and DCs, also so that the timely action may be initiated at their level.
