

## **Minutes of Meeting with LDMs/ Nodal Official- District Level Coordinators of Oil Companies and UIDAI officials on 27.02.2015**

A meeting was convened by SLBC Delhi with the LDMs/ Nodal Officers- District Level Coordinators of Oil Companies and UIDAI officials on 27.02.2015 at Oriental Bank of Commerce, Harsha Bhawan, E-Block, Connaught Place, New Delhi under the Chairmanship Sh Navleen Kundra, General Manager OBC, Convener SLBC-Delhi.

The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the strategy to bridge the gap between the Aadhaar seeding with LPG distributor and banks, as decided in the 78<sup>th</sup> SLBC Meeting held on 23.02.2015.

Sh. Navleen Kundra, Convenor SLBC, Delhi State welcomed the participants and informed the house that the NCT is 100% saturated in terms of Aadhaar. He further informed that presently Aadhaar seeding at the Distributors level is 60.71% whereas at Banks level it is only 47.69%, thus a gap of 13.02% still persists, which is a matter of concern and it must be reduced to zero level by 31.03.2015. He also observed that the presence from the OMCs side was not upto the desired level. Only four DLCs (two each from HPCL and IOCL) were present and no representative from BPCL was present in the meeting.

The following Action Points were discussed and decided in the Meeting:-

1. The total Cash Transfer Complaint (CTC) consumers are 63.70%, which includes both ATC (Aadhaar Transfer Compliant) and BTC (Bank Transfer Complaint) as against the 100% Aadhaar and PMJDY saturation in NCT of Delhi. The OMC representatives should advise the LPG Distributors to educate and pursue those LPG consumers to submit their Aadhaar details to the Banks, who have submitted the Aadhaar no. with them but yet not submitted it to their respective banks.
2. IOC is already providing district wise customer bank details and Aadhaar numbers in the cases in which Aadhaar is seeded with LPG dealers but not seeded with Bank. BPCL and HPCL were also requested to provide these district wise details to all LDMs for onward submission to their concerned DCOs / Controllers of Banks for compliance.
3. Some bank branches have entered the Aadhaar in the KYC details but not seeded the same in the bank account for DBT. All the Banksqbranches should ensure the correct and complete seeding of Aadhaar for smooth transfer of subsidy/ benefits under the scheme.
4. The DCOs of Banks should sensitise the BanksqBranches to educate and pursue the customers to submit the Aadhaar at the respective LPG distributor and Bank. The poster of PAHAL scheme may also be displayed at the Bank branches having the OMC helpline no. 1800-2333-555 (Toll Free) for enquiry regarding subsidy and Mobile no. \*99\*99# for enquiry regarding linkage of banks accounts with Aadhaar.
5. It was requested to note and take necessary action on the above mentioned points/ suggestions.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks by Sh. Vijay Khanduja, LDM New Delhi.
