

MINUTES OF THE MEETING CONVENED BY SLBC-DELHI STATE WITH LEAD DISTRICT MANAGERS OF DELHI STATE ON 23.12.2014 FOR REVIEW OF PRADHAN MANTRI JANDHAN YOJANA (PMJDY)

A Review Meeting on Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) was held today at Oriental Bank of Commerce, SLBC Cell, 2nd Floor, Harsha Bhawan, E-Block, Connaught Place, New Delhi with the Lead District Managers of Delhi State under the Chairmanship of Shri K.S.Shergill, General Manager, Convenor, SLBC- Delhi State. Shri Shergill welcomed the participants and wanted to know the status of saturation of their districts in respect of opening of bank accounts of uncovered households surveyed by them. The Lead District Managers of the following districts confirmed 100 % saturation of their districts:

The Lead District managers of East and New Delhi districts assured to achieve 100 % saturation in opening of bank accounts of uncovered households surveyed by them by 24.12.2014 whereas the LDMs of Central, South, South East, South West and Shahdra districts assured to do so latest by 26.12.2014. Shri Shergill reminded them that, otherwise also, the exercise has to be completed by 26.12.2014 as per assurance given by the controlling heads of the banks in the Review Meeting on
